SCHOOL DEVELOPMENT

MOT met Micheál Martin in June 2019 and Micheál Martin agreed to try to progress the school development with the Dept. of Education. Currently there are two applications with the Dept. of Ed.

- 1. **Emergency Works Applications** – Replacement of Porta cabins due to some of the existing ones being condemned after the H&S assessment being carried out. Two of the Girls dormitories are currently being used as classrooms.*
- 2. **Summer Works Application** – Boilers, and Bathroom facilities.*

*Micheál Martin did work on this for the school as promised but then the Dept. of Ed. approached MOT and asked that we 'pull back' a bit as they're trying to progress the "full school development". Recently MOT has been told that there is a possible "Technical Visit" due to be made to the school which is being viewed as a very positive sign of movement. **No date as yet.***

UNIQUE SCHOOL COMMUNICATIONS - APP

It was previously agreed that the Cumman na d'Tuismitheoirí would fund the initial "Build Fee" of €4,299 to formulate the app. The school is due to pay the Cumann approx. €4,500 in re-registration fees but this will now be kept by CAP and used for the App. 5 Teachers have been appointed to work on getting this app up and running. MOT confirmed that 2 parents/guardians will have access to the app.

It was also agreed that next year when CAP is confirming the student's slot at the bag packing a mobile number from someone on the Cumann will be included should they need to be contacted regarding same.

YOUNG SCIENTIST EXHIBITION

This year the school will have 3 groups representing CAP at the Young Scientist Exhibition in Dublin. MOT informed the meeting that the participating students will travel by Train and spend 2 nights in Dublin at a cost of approx. €1,000.
